India to Become Global Hub for Artificial Intelligence: PM



Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated RAISE 2020, a Mega Virtual Summit on Artificial Intelligence (AI) on 5th October. Speaking on the occasion, PM mentioned that India has led the world in knowledge & learning and will continue to digitally excel and delight the world. PM stressed how the world's largest unique identity system

- Aadhaar along with the world's most innovative digital payments system - UPI has enabled providing access to digital services, including financial services, like Direct Cash Transfers to the poor and marginalised. During the pandemic, it has enabled in reaching out to people with help, at the earliest and in the most efficient manner. PM Modi wished India to become a global hub for Artificial Intelligence and hoped many more Indians would start working on this in the times to come.



Proud Moment for India: Eight Beaches Recommended by Government Gets International Blue Flag Certification



It is a proud moment for India as 8 beaches of India, spread across five states and two union territories, have been awarded the "BLUE FLAG" by an International Jury comprising of eminent members viz UNEP, UNWTO, FEE, IUCN. The beaches that have been awarded the 'BLUE FLAG" are Shivrajpur (Dwarka-Gujarat), Ghoghla (Diu), Kasarkod and Padubidri (Karnataka), Kappad (Kerala), Rushikonda (AP), Golden (Puri-Odisha) and Radhanagar (A&N Islands). "India is also the first country in "Asia-Pacific" region which has achieved this feat in just about 2 years' time", Union Minister of Environment, Forest and Climate Change Prakash Javadekar said.

Inauguration of Irrigation Project in Nghia Lo Town of Yen Bai Province



Marking another concrete outcome in India's long-standing development partnership with Vietnam, an irrigation project inaugurated in Nghia Lo town of Yen Bai province in northern Vietnam on 10.10.2020. The project, involving a 2.1 km long in-field canal, was implemented under Government of India's Quick Impact Project programme and completed in a short span of six months with an Indian grant assistance of US\$ 50,000. It is providing irrigation for 70 hectares of farmland and bringing direct benefits to over 250 households in the locality.

Rishikesh: Yoga Capital of the World

Located in the state of Uttarakhand, Rishikesh is the hub of sages, yoga practitioners and pilgrims, who throng the ghats (stepped banks of a river) and temples. Rishikesh offers a resplendent view of the grand aarti that lights up the banks in the evenings with new rays of hope. It is the starting point for the Hindu Char pilgrimage, Dham including Yamunotri. Gangotri, Kedarnath and Badrinath, to seek spiritual salvation. Rishikesh is also called the 'Yoga capital of the world'. For adventurous, Rishikesh is the place for starting their trekking expeditions and excursions towards the Himalayan peaks.

India is the world's largest milk producing nation. India's food ecosystem offers huge opportunities for investments with stimulating growth in the food retail sector, favourable economic policies and attractive fiscal incentives. The Food & Grocery market in India is the sixth largest in the world. Food & Grocery retail market in India further constitutes almost 65% of the total retail market in India. 100% FDI is permitted under the automatic route in Food processing industries. 100% FDI is allowed through government approval route for trading, including through e-commerce in respect of food products manufactured or produced in India.
