### PM Dedicates Two Future-Ready Ayurveda Institutions to the Nation on Ayurveda Day



The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi dedicated two future-ready Ayurveda institutions to the nation on the 5th Ayurveda Day on 13 November via video conferencing. These are the Institute of Teaching & Research in Ayurveda (ITRA), Jamnagar and the National Institute of Ayurveda (NIA), Jaipur. Both the Institutes are premier institutions of Ayurveda in the country. The Ministry of AYUSH, since 2016, has been observing 'Ayurveda Day' every year on the occasion of Dhanwantari Jayanti (Dhanteras). PM stressed the need to bring the ayurveda knowledge out of books, scriptures and home remedies and develop this ancient knowledge as per modern needs. Ayurveda is not just an alternative today but is one of the key basis of the country's health policy, PM Modi said.

### 12th BRICS Summit



Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi led India's participation at the 12th BRICS Summit, convened under the Chairship of President Vladimir Putin of Russia on 17 November 2020, in a virtual format. The theme of the Summit was "Global Stability, Shared Security and Innovative Growth". President Jair Bolsonaro of Brazil, President Xi Jinping of China and President Cyril Ramaphosa of South Africa also participated in the Summit. He noted that BRICS has played a significant role in fight against terrorism and in promoting the global economy. PM Modi called for necessary reform of the UN and especially the Security Council, and other international bodies like WTO, IMF, WHO etc. to make them relevant to contemporary realities. PM called for cooperation in addressing the Covid-19 pandemic and in this regard noted the supply of essential medicines to over 150 countries by India. At the conclusion of the Summit, BRICS Leaders adopted the "Moscow Declaration".

### 15th G20 Summit




Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, participated in the 15th G20 Summit convened by Saudi Arabia in virtual format, on 21-22 November 2020. The Summit under Saudi Presidency centered on the theme "Realizing Opportunities of 21st Century for All" which has assumed greater importance in the wake of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. The agenda of the Summit over two days with two sessions focused overcoming the pandemic, economic recovery and restoring jobs, and building an inclusive, sustainable and resilient future and a side event on safeguarding the planet. PM termed the COVID-19 pandemic as an important turning point in history of humanity and the biggest challenge the world is facing since the World War II. He called for decisive action by G20, not limited to economic recovery, jobs and trade, but to focus on preserving Planet Earth noting that all of us are trustees of humanity's future.

### India's AI Supercomputer Param Siddhi 63rd among Top 500 Most Powerful Non-Distributed Computer Systems in the World

Param Siddhi, the high performance computing-artificial intelligence (HPC-AI) supercomputer, jointly developed by Department of Science & Technology (DST) and Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India under National Supercomputing Mission (NSM) at C-DAC, has achieved global ranking of 63 in TOP 500 most powerful non-distributed computer systems in the world. This will accelerate R&D in war against COVID-19 through faster simulations, medical imaging, genome sequencing and forecasting and is a boon for Indian masses and for start-Ups and MSMEs in particular.

### 15th East Asia Summit

External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar represented India at the 15th East Asia Summit (EAS) on 14 November 2020. The Summit was chaired by the Prime Minister of Vietnam H.E. Nguyen Xuan Phuc in his capacity as ASEAN Chair. EAM, in his remarks, re-affirmed the importance of EAS as the Leaders-led forum to exchange views on strategic issues. He spoke of the importance of adhering to international law, respecting territorial integrity and sovereignty, and promoting a rules-based global order. The Summit discussed ways to strengthen the EAS platform and to make it more responsive to emerging challenges on its 15th anniversary and adopted the Ha Noi Declaration. The Leaders underlined the importance of cooperation in ensuring safe, effective, and affordable access to COVID-19 vaccines.


### Ambassador's Presentation on India's Development Strategy


### Ambassador's Meeting with Deputy Minister of Public Security

### Ambassador Meets Chief of General Political Department, Vietnam



## Ayurveda Day 2020



On 13th November, Embassy celebrated Ayurveda Day 2020. The Ministry of AYUSH, since 2016, has been observing 'Ayurveda Day' every year on the occasion of Dhanwantari Jayanti (Dhanteras). Ayurveda, a natural system of medicine, is widely considered by scholars to be the oldest healthcare system. It originated in India more than 3,000 years ago. Some scholars place its antiquity to 5,000 years. The basic principles of Ayurveda include the concepts of universal interconnectedness, the body's

constitution (prakriti), and life forces (doshas). Ayurvedic treatments aim to eliminate impurities, reduce symptoms, increase resistance to disease, reduce worry, and increase harmony in life. Herbs and other plants, including oils and common spices, are used extensively in Ayurvedic treatment.

## Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana - Paving the Way to Boost Rural Connectivity in New India



India with a total road network of 5.5 mn km comprises of national & state highways and urban & rural roads. National highways account for 2% of the total road network and carry over 40% of total traffic. India has a well-developed framework for Public-Private-Partnerships (PPP) in the highway sector. Asian Development Bank ranked India at first spot in PPP operational maturity and also designated India as a developed market for PPPs. The Government launched the Bharatmala Pariyojana, which aims to build 66,100 km of economic corridors, border and coastal roads, and expressways to boost the highway network. The first phase of the programme will bring in \$82 bn investments by 2022 for the development of 34,800 km of highways.

## Vaishali: One of the World's First Republics



Documented as being the capital of Licchavi (or Lichchavi), one of the world's first republics with an elected assembly of administrators and an efficient administration, Vaishali, in modern-day Bihar, is known as one of the greatest cities of the 6th century BC. The city finds a mention in Ramayana too. It is said Lord Buddha came to Vaishali around five years after his enlightenment, when he was invited here to end the sufferings of the city's residents. It was also in Vaishali that the first group of women were ordained into Buddhism. Vaishali is also famous for being the place where Lord Buddha delivered his last sermon.
