PM Launches Avushman Bharat PM-JAY SEHAT to Extend Coverage to All **Residents of Jammu & Kashmir**



Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi launched Ayushman Bharat PM-JAY SEHAT to extend coverage to all residents of Jammu & Kashmir through video conference. Talking about the Jammu and Kashmir Ayushman Bharat PM-JAY SEHAT scheme, PM Modi said getting free treatment up to 5 lakh rupees under this scheme would improve the ease of living. Right now, about 6 lakh families of the Union Territory are getting the benefit of Ayushman Bharat Scheme. All 21 lakh families will get the same benefit after the SEHAT scheme. He added another benefit of this scheme would be that treatment is not limited to government and private hospitals in Jammu and Kashmir only. Rather, treatment can be availed from thousands of hospitals empanelled under this scheme in the country. He further said that the development of the people of Jammu and Kashmir is one of the biggest priorities of his government.

PM Inaugurates India's First-Ever **Driverless Train Operations on Delhi Metro's Magenta Line**



On 28 December, Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated India's first-ever driverless train operations on Delhi Metro's Magenta Line through a video conference. The National Common Mobility Card was also expanded to the Airport Express Line of Delhi Metro, which was started in Ahmedabad last year. Speaking on the occasion, PM lamented the fact that a few decades ago, when the demand of urbanisation was felt, there was not much attention given to the needs of the future, half-hearted work was done, and confusion persisted. He said unlike this, modern thinking says that urbanization should not be seen as a challenge but used as an opportunity to build better infrastructure in the country, an opportunity through which we can enhance Ease of Living. He said this difference of thinking is seen now in every dimension of urbanization. Prime Minister said with the achievement of Metro Rail without a driver, our country has joined the select countries of the world where such facilities are available.

United States Confers 'Legion of Merit' Award on Prime Minister Narendra Modi



The President of the United States of America conferred the highest decoration, The Legion of Merit, Degree Chief Commander, to Prime Minister Narendra Modi on 21 December 2020. The award is in recognition of the Prime Minister's steadfast leadership and vision for India's emergence as a global power, and exemplary contribution made by him for the advancement of the India-United States strategic partnership and



promoting global peace and prosperity. The Legion of Merit, in the highest degree of the Chief Commander, is a prestigious award conferred by the President of the United States, typically upon Heads of State or Heads of Government of other countries. The award was received on behalf of the Prime Minister by the Ambassador of India to the United States Taranjit Singh Sandhu. At the ceremony, The Legion of Merit, Degree Chief Commander, was also awarded to the Prime Minister of Australia Scott Morrison, and former Prime Minister of Japan, Shinzo Abe.

India's Economy Could Prove to Be 'Most Resilient' in Subregion over Long Term: UN report



India's economy could prove to be the "most resilient" in the subregion of South and South-West Asia over the long term, said a report by the United Nations, stating that a positive but lower economic growth post-COVID-19 pandemic and the country's large market will continue to attract investments. According to the report "Foreign Direct Investment Trends And Outlook In Asia And The Pacific 2020/2021", compiled by



United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP), Foreign Direct Investment flows to South and South-West Asia slightly decreased by 2 percent in 2019, from \$67 billion in 2018 to \$66 billion in 2019. The growth, however, was mainly driven by India, which accounted for 77 percent of the total inflows and received \$51 billion in 2019, up 20 percent from the previous year, it said. The report noted that the majority of these flows were destined for the information and communications technology (ICT) and the construction sub-sector.
