PM Inaugurates World Sustainable Development Summit 2021



On 10 February, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated virtual World Sustainable Development Summit 2021. The theme of the Summit was 'Redefining our common future: Safe and secure environment for all'. Addressing the event, PM said that two things will define how the progress journey of humanity will unfold in the times to come- first is the health of our people and second is the health of our planet, both are inter-linked. emphasized on climate justice for fighting against climate change. PM further said that India's intent is supported by concrete action. Powered by spirited public efforts, India is on track to exceed its commitments and targets from Paris Agreement. India is committed to reduce emissions intensity of GDP by 33 to 35 percent from 2005 levels. He also shared that India is well on track to setting up 450 giga watts of Renewable Energy generating capacity by 2030.

Around a month after India started indigenously developed sendina COVID-19 vaccines to partner countries under grant assistance programme named "Vaccine Maitri", the global media has offered lavish praise for India. India had started its Vaccine Maitri programme on 20 January with first batches of COVID-19 vaccine consignment sent to Bhutan and the Maldives. The Serum Institute of India, the world's largest vaccine factory, churns out the AstraZeneca-Oxford vaccine at a daily



rate of about 2.5 million doses. That pace has allowed India to begin to dole out doses free of charge to neighbours. The vaccine push bolsters India's credibility as a reliable crisis-responder and solutions provider to these neighbouring countries.

Richly endowed with natural resources, India produces as many as 95 minerals. India is the second largest coal and crude steel producer as well as the fourth largest iron ore producer in the world. With the launch of the National Mineral Policy 2019, India presents a major opportunity for investors. ### Ajanta Caves- 2nd-century Epicentre of Buddhist Art & Culture

Located about 107 km from Aurangabad, the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Aianta Caves are a famous cluster of 32 Buddhist caves. The rock-hewn caves at Aianta are either chaitvas (shrine), chapels or praver or viharas (monasteries) residential cells. Ajanta displays the Gandhara and Mathura schools of art from the Kushana period; the Sarnath school of art from the Gupta period; and the Amaravati school of art from the late Satavahana and Ikshvaku periods. The Ajanta paintings recount the life of Lord Buddha, including his previous earthly experiences and the Jataka tales.


