Defence Minister of India Calls for Open & Inclusive Order in Indo-Pacific at the 8th ADMM Plus

Defence Minister of India, Shri Rajnath Singh called for an open and inclusive order in Indo-Pacific based upon respect for sovereignty and territorial integrity of nations while addressing the 8th ASEAN Defence Ministers Meeting (ADMM) Plus on June 16. India Develops a New Rapid COVID-19 Testing Kit

Under the aegis of COVID-19 Research Consortium, DBT-BIRAC supported product 'SENSIT Rapid COVID-19 Ag kit' has been developed by Ubio Biotechnology Systems Pvt. Ltd. for qualitative detection of SARS CoV-2 Nucleocapsid Protein with an assay time of 15 minutes. The samples are collected using nasopharyngeal swabs from the suspected individual. This ICMR approved kit is a chromatographic immunoassay, which allows the healthcare personnel to visually read the test result.

DRDO Successfully Test Fires Enhanced "Pinaka" Rocket



Continuing the development of Artillery Rocket Systems, India's Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully test fired extended range version of indigenously developed "Pinaka" rocket from a Multi-Barrel Rocket Launcher (MBRL) on 24th and 25th June 2021 at Integrated Test Range (ITR), Chandipur off the coast of Odisha.

Twenty-five Enhanced Pinaka Rockets were launched in quick succession against targets at different ranges. All the mission objectives were met during the launches. The enhanced range version of Pinaka Rocket System can destroy targets at distances up to 45 kms.

SARNATH: The Site of Lord Buddha's First Teachings





Sarnath, 10km from Varanasi, is one of the most revered Buddhist pilgrimage centers. After attaining the Enlightenment at Bodh Gaya, it was here that Lord Buddha preached his first sermon, sanctified as Maha Dharm Chakra Pravartan. The great Dhamekh Stupa and several other structures stand testimony to the importance the place enjoyed at that time. The Chaukhandi Stupa is the place where, during his first visit to Sarnath, Lord Buddha met his first five disciples. The area is a treasure trove of archaeological findings such as Dharmrajika Stupa and Mulgandhkuti Vihar. The smooth glistening pillar established by Emperor Ashoka in 273-232 B.C. marks the foundation of the Buddhist Sangha, and the Lion Capital atop this pillar is now India's National Emblem. Its reputation as a center of Buddhist learning spreads far and wide and is a revered location and a great attraction for tourists from across the world.

India's Foreign Trade: May 2021

India's overall exports (Merchandise and Services combined) in April-May 2021 are estimated to be US\$98.29 billion, exhibiting a positive growth of 56.94 per cent over the same period last year. Overall imports in April-May 2021 are estimated to be US\$104.14 billion, exhibiting a positive growth of 77.82 per cent over the same period last year.





Medical Device Sector: Fostering Innovation for Improved Health



The medical devices industry in India consists of large multinationals as well as small and medium enterprises (SMEs) growing at an unprecedented scale. The current market size of the medical devices industry in India is estimated to be US\$11 billion. The Medical device sector is projected to register a CAGR of 14.8% and is expected to reach US\$11.86 bn in 2021-22, Moreover, the sector is likely to grow to US\$65 billion-industry by 2024. India's medical devices industry is poised for significant growth in the next five years.

Vietnam's Deputy Minister of Defence Received Ambassador

Senior Lieutenant General Nguyen Chi Vinh, former Deputy Minister of Defense received Ambassador on 14 June. At the meeting, Senior Lieutenant General Vinh Ambassador for thanked promoting defence cooperation between the two countries. He affirmed that Vietnam always considers India a sincere and reliable friend and that it supports India's "Act East" policy. Ambassador highly appreciated Senior Lieutenant Vinh's contributions in advancing the India-Vietnam defense cooperation, thereby promoting the Comprehensive Strategic Partnership between the two countries.

India-Vietnam Cooperation in UN Peacekeeping

An online workshop was held on 17 June between the Indian Centre for UN Peacekeeping and the Vietnam Department of Peacekeeping Operations to discuss measures to enhance cooperation in UN peacekeeping. Speaking on the occasion, the Vietnamese side emphasized Vietnam's commitments for playing a more active role in the UN peacekeeping field. They requested India to assist Vietnam in this endeavour. The two sides agreed to exchange information on the peacekeeping issues. They also discussed the possibility to start the Vietnam-India Bilateral Army Exercise (VINBAX) and put forth a threeyear Defence Cooperation Plan.
