Prime Minister Modi Addressed The Nation from The Ramparts of The Red Fort on The 75th Independence Day



Prime Minister Modi said that on 15 August 2021, on the pious festival of the Amrit Mahotsav of freedom, India bowed to all its freedom fighters and brave heroes who continued to sacrifice themselves day and night in the defense of the nation. He said that India should not limit the occasion of 75 years of Indian independence to just one ceremony but must lay the groundwork

for and move forward with new resolutions. Starting from here, the entire journey of the next 25 years, when India celebrates the centenary of Indian independence and marks the *Amrit* period of creation of a new India. The fulfilment of India's resolutions in this period would take the nation to the hundredth anniversary of Indian independence with pride. PM Modi wished and desired that when the country completed 100 years of independence, the goals of the countrymen must be turned into reality.

In his address, Prime Minister Modi announced the National Hydrogen Mission and pledged to make India a **Global Hub for Green Hydrogen Production and Export**. This would not only help India to make a new progress in the field of energy self-reliance but India would also become a new inspiration for Clean Energy Transition all over the world. He also announced the launch the launch of the **National Master Plan of 'Gati Shakti'** which will meet the great need for



adopting a holistic and integrated approach in modern infrastructure construction.

Prime Minister Modi's Remarks at UN Security Council High-Level Open Debate on Maritime Security



During India's Presidency of the UN Security Council in August 2021, Prime Minister Modi chaired a high-level virtual open debate on "Enhancing Maritime Security – A Case for International Cooperation" on 9 August. This was the first time the issue of maritime security was discussed at the UN Security Council. A

<u>Presidential Statement</u> was also adopted. During his remarks at the event, <u>Prime</u> <u>Minister Modi underlined</u> that the ocean is a joint heritage, sea routes are the lifeline of international trade, and the oceans are important for the future of the whole planet.

He highlighted that:

- Barriers from legitimate maritime trade must be removed.
- The settlement of maritime disputes must be peaceful and on the basis of international law only.
- Natural disasters and maritime threats created by non-state actors must be faced together.
- The maritime environment and maritime resources have to be preserved.
- Responsible maritime connectivity must be encouraged.

India Extends Grant Assistance for Army Software Park at the Telecommunication University in Nha Trang

Ambassador Pranay Verma hands over a cheque of US\$ one million to Deputy Minister of Defence, Senior Lt. Gen. Hoang Xuan Chien at the Ministry of National Defence of Vietnam on 11 August 2021.
