Higher priority for investment in Aspirational Districts & Tier

Taking steps forward towards the vision of an 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat', the Government of India has approved the PLI Scheme for Textiles for MMF Apparel, MMF Fabrics and 10 segments/products of Technical Textiles with a budgetary outlay of Rs. 106.8 billion (US\$1.4 billion). The PLI scheme for Textiles is part of the overall announcement of PLI Schemes for 13 sectors made earlier during the Union Budget 2021-22. With the announcement of PLI Schemes for 13 sectors, minimum production in India is expected to be around Rs. 37.5 trillion (US\$509 billion) over 5 years and minimum expected employment over 5 years is nearly 10 million. PLI scheme for Textiles will promote production of high value MMF Fabric, Garments and Technical Textiles in the country.

Indian Navy To Get DRDO Developed Naval Anti Drone System

The Indian Navy has signed contract with Navratna Defence PSU Bharat Limited (BEL) for supply of the first indigenous comprehensive Naval Anti Drone System (NADS) in New Delhi on 31 August 2021. The NADS, developed by DRDO and manufactured by BEL, is the first indigenously developed anti-drone system to be inducted

into the Indian Armed Forces. Multiple Units of BEL and





DRDO Labs, in close collaboration with the Indian Navy, were involved in the making of this fully indigenous system, as part of the Atmanirbar Bharat initiative to counter drone threats of adversaries. The BEL is to sign similar contracts with Army and Air Force also.

Government Provides Big Boost To **Exporters**



Under the decisive leadership of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, the Government of India has decided to budget Rs 560 billion

(US\$7.6 billion) in this Financial Year (FY) 21-22 to disburse all pending export incentives. Benefits would be disbursed to more than 45,000 exporters, out of which about 98% are small exporters in the MSME category. Exports in India have seen robust growth in recent months. Merchandise exports for April-August, 2021 was nearly US\$164 billion, which is an increase of 67% over 2020-21 and 23% over 2019-20. This decision to clear all pending export incentives within this FY will lead to even more rapid export growth in coming months.

Centre Increases Minimum Support Prices For Winter Crops For 2022-23

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs chaired by PM Shri Narendra Modi on 8 September approved the increase in the Minimum Prices Support



(MSP) for all mandated Rabi crops for Rabi Marketing Season (RMS) 2022-23 to ensure remunerative prices to the growers for their produce. The increase in MSP for Rabi Crops for RMS 2022-23 is in line with the Union Budget 2018-19 announcement of fixing the MSPs at a level of at least 1.5 times of the all-India weighted average cost of production, aiming a reasonably fair remuneration for the farmers. The expected returns to farmers over their cost of production are estimated to be highest in case of wheat and rapeseed & mustard (100% each), followed by lentil (79%); gram (74%).


India on 17 September achieved the highest ever vaccination figure of 25 million doses administered in 24 hours and crossed the 800 million mark the next day. So far, 6 states/UTs in India have vaccinated 100% of their population with at least 1 dose.

According to Dr. Pham Sy Thanh, Director of Vietnam's Mekong-China Strategic Research Program, who has written a <u>series of articles</u> on India's vaccination programme, India's remarkable vaccine coverage rate is a result of a clear vaccination strategy that includes: (1) Producing vaccines as quickly as possible; (2) Having organized logistics, storage and

distribution; (3) Using digital transformation to increase the efficiency of vaccine distribution, preservation and vaccination; (4) Identifying priority groups for vaccination to minimize the mortality rate. This is known as the three-phase national vaccination strategy, with a lot of valuable experience that other developing countries, especially those with scarce vaccine resources, can apply to achieve effective results in controlling mortality and resuming economic activity.

With 19 medals - five gold, eight silver, six bronze - Tokyo 2020 was India's best-ever Paralympics. There were several historic firsts to celebrate as well, with Bhavina Patel becoming the first Indian table tennis player to win a Paralympic medal and Harvinder Singh mirroring the feat in archery. Shooter Avani Lekhara, however, was the standout name as she became the first Indian woman to win a Paralympic gold medal.

Upon the return of the Indian Contingent, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi hosted them at his residence and congratulated them for their record-breaking historic performance at the Games. He said that their achievement will significantly boost the morale of the entire sporting community in the country, and budding sports persons will feel encouraged to come forward to take up sports.

A total of 52 companies have filed their application with committed investment of Rs 58.66 billion (US\$830 million) under the PLI Scheme for White Goods (Air Conditioners and LED lights).

The PLI Scheme for White Goods to be implemented over FY 2021-22 to FY 2028-29 with an outlay of Rs. 62 billion (US\$846 million) was approved by the Union Cabinet on 7th April 2021. It is designed to create complete component ecosystem for Air Conditioners and LED Lights Industry in India and make India an integral part of the global supply chains. The Scheme shall extend an incentive of 4% to 6% on incremental sales for a period of 5 years subsequent to the base year and one year of gestation period.



Ambassador highlighted the new opportunities in promoting Indian textile exports to Vietnam and underlined the significance of recent policy measures taken by Government of India, including the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme for Textiles, that will reposition India's textile industry at the forefront of global production and value chains.



Interactive Meeting On India-Vietnam Trade On Agro And Allied Commodities



As part of efforts to promote agricultural cooperation and trade between India and Vietnam, the Embassy hosted an interactive webinar with the regulatory authorities of the two countries on 13 September 2021 to exchange views on the entire spectrum of regulatory and market access issues and promote better mutual understanding of each other's safety and quality standards in agriculture trade. Agriculture and allied commodities are an important component of India-Vietnam bilateral trade, accounting for nearly 20% of the trade basket in 2020-21.

Agriculture trade brings direct benefits to farming communities of the two countries and therefore, an important priority in Embassy's trade promotion activities. Agricultural cooperation has also been one of the mainstays of traditional bilateral cooperation between India and Vietnam as symbolized by iconic Indian development projects in Vietnam such as the Cuu Long Delta Rice Research Institute and Southern Fruit Research Institute (SOFRI) in Tien Giang.

Embassy Celebrates Hindi Day 2021



On the occasion of Hindi Day on 14 September, the Embassy of India and Swami Vivekananda Cultural Center organized a series of programmes to celebrate the adoption of Hindi Language as the official language of India by the Constituent Assembly in 1949.
