PM Modi at SCO Summit



At the invitation of the President of Uzbekistan, H.E. Mr. Shavkat Narendra Mirziyoyev, Prime Minister Modi visited Samarkand, Uzbekistan on 15-16 September to attend the 22nd Meeting of the Council of Heads of State the Shanghai Cooperation of Organization (SCO). During the Summit, the leaders reviewed the organization's activities over the past two decades, and discussed the state and prospects of

multilateral cooperation in the future. In his address, PM Modi noted the important role of SCO as SCO member countries contribute about 30% of global GDP and 40% of the world's population. SCO must make efforts to develop reliable, resilient and diversified supply chains in the region. India is on track to become a manufacturing hub with young and talented workforce giving the country a competitive edge. India's economy is expected to grow by 7.5% this year, which will be the highest among the world's largest economies. A lot of focus is also being given on the proper use of technology. Today, there are more than 70,000 start-

PM Launches National Logistics Policy

ups in India, of which more than 100 are unicorns.

To boost the ease of doing business and enhance the liveability quotient, Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched the National Logistics Policy (NLP) on 17 September in New Delhi. The policy aims to lower the cost of logistics from the existing 13-14% and lead it to par with other developed countries. This will increase the competitiveness of Indian products in both the Indian home market and the international market. Moreover, the reduced cost will also increase efficiency efforts cutting across all sectors of the economy, which encourages value addition and enterprise.



The NLP also aims to promote seamless movement of goods and enhances the competitiveness of Indian industries. It seeks to reduce the logistics cost from 16% of GDP to a global average of 8% by 2030. As per the estimates, the worth of the Indian logistics market will be around US\$ 215 bn in the next two years compared to US\$ 160 bn. This sector employs more than 22 million people in India, which through skill development is expected to grow at the rate of 5% in 5 years.

India will assume the Presidency of the G20 for one year from 01 December 2022 to 30 November 2023. Under its Presidency, India is expected to host over 200 G20 meetings across the country, beginning December 2022. The G20 Leaders' Summit at the level of Heads of State/Government is scheduled to be held on 09 and 10 September 2023 in New Delhi. During its Presidency, India, Indonesia and Brazil would form the troika the first time when the troika would consist of three developing countries and emerging economies, providing them a greater voice.

Second India–Vietnam Security Dialogue

The Second India-Vietnam security dialogue at the level of Deputy National Security Advisor was held in New Delhi on 13 September. The National Security Council Secretariat (NSCS) was led by the Deputy National Security Adviser, Vikram Misri, while the Ministry of Public Security (MPS) of Vietnam was led by the Deputy Minister of Ministry of Public Security, Senior Lieutenant General Luong Tam Quang.



During the meeting, both sides had a frank discussion on a number of issues of mutual interest. Deputy NSA

Misri reiterated Prime Minister Modi's Indo-Pacific Oceans Initiative (IPOI), which focused on a collaborative effort to conserve, sustain and secure the maritime domain. The two sides agreed that coordinated efforts are needed to combat radicalization, terrorism, and the production and trafficking of illegal narcotics and arms in the region. Deputy Minister Lt General Quang called on National Secretary Adviser and also met Secretary (East), MEA.

• PM Flags Off new Vande Bharat Express



Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and Indian Army have successfully completed six flight-tests of Quick Reaction Surface to Air Missile (QRSAM) system from Integrated Test Range (ITR) Chandipur off the Odisha coast. The flight tests were conducted as part of evaluation trials by the Indian Army.

The flight-tests were carried out against highspeed aerial targets mimicking various types of threats to evaluate the capability of the weapon

systems under different scenarios, including long range medium altitude, short range, high altitude manoeuvring target, low radar signature with receding & crossing target and salvo launch with two missiles fired in quick succession. The system performance was also evaluated under day and night operation scenarios. During these tests, all the mission objectives were met establishing pin-point accuracy of the weapon system with state-of-the-art guidance and control algorithms including warhead chain.

In a major step towards making India self-sufficient in the critical area of semiconductors and displays, the joint venture of Vedanta and Foxxcon on 13 September signed two MoUs with the Government of Gujarat to set up a semiconductor fab unit, a display fab unit, and a semiconductor assembling and testing unit in Ahmedabad district. The project envisages total investment of Rs 1,540 billion (~US\$19 billion), and it will provide employment to around 100,000 people.



Prime Minister Narendra Modi has expressed optimism after Government of Gujarat signed the MoUs. He pointed out that the investment will create a significant impact to boost economy and jobs while also help in creating a huge ecosystem for ancillary industries and thereby helping India's MSMEs.

Indian economy to expand by 7.3% in FY23

The Indian economy is expected to grow by 7.3% in the current fiscal year, which ends in March, but inflation is expected to continue above the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) upper tolerance level of 6% till the end of 2022, according to the latest projection from global rating agency S&P. According to S&P's report on Asia-Pacific economic outlook, even though they expect negative risks, they have kept the India growth prediction at 7.3% for fiscal year 2022-23 and 6.5% for the following fiscal year.



Varanasi Nominated as First-ever SCO Tourism and Cultural Capital





The city of Varanasi has been nominated as the first-ever SCO Tourism and Cultural Capital during the period 2022-2023 at the 22nd Meeting of Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) Council of Heads of State in Uzbekistan on 16 September.

The nomination of Varanasi as the first ever SCO Tourism and Cultural Capital will promote tourism, cultural and

humanitarian exchanges between India and the SCO member Countries. It also underlines India's ancient civilizational links with Member States of SCO, especially the Central Asian Republics. Under the framework of this major cultural outreach program, a number of events will be hosted in Varanasi during 2022-23, for which guests will be invited to participate from SCO Member States. These events are expected to attract Indologists, scholars, authors, musicians and artists, photo journalists, travel bloggers and other invited guests.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi flagged off Gandhinagar-Mumbai Vande Bharat Express at Gandhinagar station and travelled on the train from there to Kalupur Railway Station on 30 September. The Prime Minister inspected the train coaches and interacted with his co-passengers.

Vande Bharat Express 2.0 between Gandhinagar and Mumbai is going to be a game changer and will boost connectivity between the two business hubs of India. It will enable business owners from Gujarat to travel to Mumbai and vice versa without bearing the brunt of



high-cost airline tickets. One-way travel time of Vande Bharat Express 2.0 from Gandhinagar to Mumbai is estimated at around five and a half hours. The Vande Bharat Express 2.0 offers a myriad of superior and aircraft-like travelling experiences. It is equipped with more advancements and improved features such as reaching a speed of 0 to 100 km per hour in just 52 seconds, and a maximum speed up to 180 km per hour.
