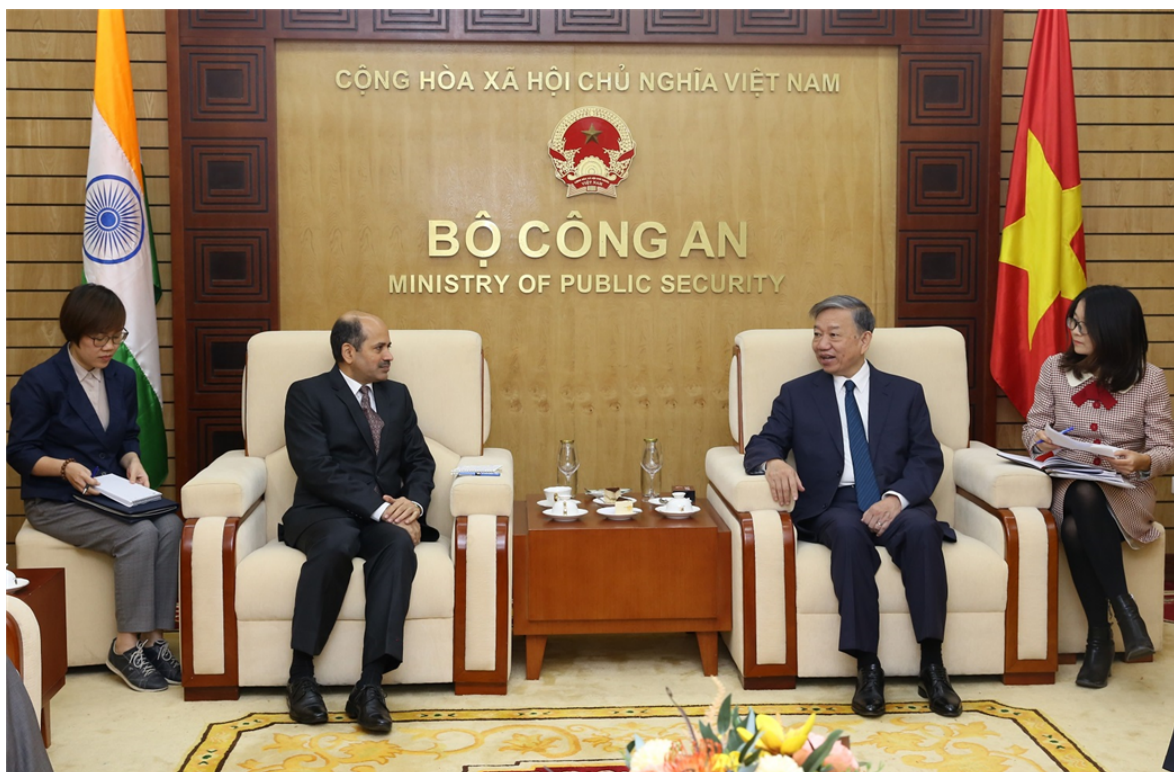
Minister To Lam and Mr. Sandeep Arya.
