


Permanent Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs Nguyen Minh Vu receives Indian Ambassador to Vietnam

The Vietnam-India Comprehensive Strategic Partnership is growing; Political cooperation is increasingly close and reliable.


This year (2022) is also the 50th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between the two countries, the Permanent Deputy Minister wished that the Ambassador would coordinate with functional agencies of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and relevant ministries and branches to continue continue to promote visits at all levels and strengthen commemorative activities in the coming time.

Economic and trade cooperation between the two countries continues to develop rapidly, two-way trade will reach 13.2 billion USD in 2021, up 36% compared to 2020 and 10.2 in 8 months of 2022. billion USD, up 18% over the same period in 2021.

Standing Deputy Minister Nguyen Minh Vu wished the Ambassador to continue promoting cooperation in trade and investment, including further opening the Indian market for Vietnamese agricultural products. Vietnam is ready to open its doors to Indian investors in such fields as processing and manufacturing technology; information and communication technology, energy, high-tech agriculture; innovation and infrastructure development,...

The Permanent Deputy Minister suggested that the Ambassador pay attention to promoting a number of potential bilateral cooperation fields such as science and technology, culture, tourism, people-to-people exchanges as well as supporting the two airlines. The party opens more direct flights between the two countries. In addition, the Permanent Deputy Minister also said that defense - security cooperation between the two countries is developing strongly, and wished the Ambassador to continue promoting cooperation in this field.
