

India's Foreign Trade Policy 2023

Minister of Commerce and Industry, Mr. Piyush Goyal on 31 March launched the Foreign Trade Policy 2023. The Key Approach to the policy is based on these 4 pillars: (i) Incentive to Remission, (ii) Export promotion through collaboration - Exporters, States, Districts, Indian Missions, (iii) Ease of doing business, reduction in transaction cost and e-initiatives and (iv) Emerging Areas - E-Commerce Developing Districts as Export Hubs and streamlining SCOMET policy.

Foreign Trade Policy 2023 aims at process reengineering and automation to facilitate ease of doing business for exporters. It also focuses on emerging areas like dual use high-end technology items under



India's overall exports, including services and merchandise exports, has already crossed US\$750 billion and is expected to cross US\$760 billion in 2023.

G20 Foreign Ministers' Meeting



G20 Foreign Ministers met on 1-2 March when the world faces multi-dimensional challenges from insufficient progress towards Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), climate change, pollution and biodiversity loss, to economic slowdown, debt distress, uneven pandemic recovery, growing poverty and inequality, food and energy insecurity and global supply chain disruptions, aggravated by geo-political tensions and conflicts.

Meeting under India's G20 Presidency, with the theme 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam' - 'One Earth. One Family. One Future', the G20 Foreign Ministers deliberated upon current global challenges. They brought focus on strengthening multilateralism, food and energy security, ambitious climate and environmental action, deepening cooperation on sustainable development, counter-terrorism, counter-narcotics, global health, global talent pool, humanitarian assistance and disaster risk reduction, as well as gender equality and women's empowerment.

Earth science satellite NISAR

In a written reply to the Rajya Sabha on 23 March, Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology Dr. Jitendra Singh informed that NASA and the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) have jointly manufactured an earth science satellite named, NISAR (NASA-ISRO Synthetic Aperture Radar).

He said that the mission objectives of the satellite are - Design, Develop and launch Dual Frequency (L and S band) Radar Imaging Satellite and to Explore newer applications areas using L & S Band microwave data, especially in surface deformation studies, terrestrial biomass structure, natural resource mapping and monitoring and studies related to dynamics of ice-sheets, glaciers, forests, oil slick etc. The spacecraft will orbit the Earth in a sun-synchronous orbit of 747 Km with an inclination of 98.4 degree for a 12-day repeat cycle.

While NASA is delivering the L-Band SAR payload, high precision GPS and 12m unfurlable antenna, ISRO is delivering S-band SAR payload, spacecraft bus and facilitating launch. The total expenditure incurred on realization of NISAR satellite by ISRO as on February, 2023 is Rs. 469.40 Crore, excluding launch cost.




Ambassador met with Vietnamese leaders









India – Vietnam Defence Exchanges







India-Vietnam <u>Army to Army Staff Talks</u> were held in Pune, India from 28 February - 1 March to discuss cooperation plans, joint excercises, training, etc. Vietnam's delegation also visited College of Military Engineering and National Defence Academy.

Later on, Staff Talks between the Indian Navy (IN) and the Vietnam People's Navy (VPN) were held at Hai Phong, Vietnam from 22 to 24 March. Indian delegation led by Rear Admiral Nirbhay Bapna also called on Rear Admiral Pham Manh Hung, Deputy Commander in Chief & Chief of Staff, Vietnam People's Navy with a view to enhancing existing bilateral naval cooperation.

In a separate exchange, Vietnamese Coast Guard officers attended <u>Maritime Law Operations course</u> at Coast Guard Training Centre, Kochi from 13 February to 10 March 2023.

ISRO launches successfully 36 satellites



In its second operational flight, LVM3 launch vehicle placed 36 satellites of OneWeb to their intended orbits from the second launch pad at Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh.

This was a dedicated commercial mission for a foreign customer through NSIL. A total of 36 OneWeb Gen-1 satellites of about 150 kg each totaling about 5,796 kg were launched to a

circular low-earth orbit of about 601km with a 87.4 degree inclination. The separation of satellites involved a unique maneuver of the cryogenic stage to orientation and reorientation covering 9 phases spanning 75 minutes. This was one of the biggest commercial orders executed by ISRO.



Defence Ministry signs deals to purchase indigenous weapons and systems

The Indian government has recently signed several defence deals worth over INR 364 billion to strengthen the country's military capabilities.

Bharat Dynamics Limited (BDL) signed a deal to supply two regiments of the upgraded Akash air defence missile system to the Indian Army, with a third and fourth regiment deal also signed at a cost of over INR 60 billion. The new missile system is equipped with an indigenous active Radio Frequency seeker, making it more accurate and effective at high-altitude frontiers.



Additionally, the Defence Ministry signed a deal with Indian shipyards for the acquisition of 11 Next Generation Offshore Patrol Vessels and six Next Generation Missile Vessels at a cost of INR 196 billion. The ships are scheduled to be delivered between September 2026 and March 2027.

The ministry also signed contracts with Bharat Electronics Limited and Bharat Dynamics Limited for the procurement of 13 Lynx-U2 Fire Control Systems for the Indian Navy for INR 10 billion. Additionally, the government has also invested in an improved Akash Weapon System and 12 Weapon Locating Radars for the Indian Army, respectively.

Consecutive successful flight tests of VSHORADS short-range missile system




Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) conducted consecutive successful flight tests of Very Short-Range Air Defence System (VSHORADS) missile at the Integrated Test Range, Chandipur off the coast of Odisha on 14 March. The flight tests were carried out from a ground-based man portable launcher against high speed unmanned aerial targets, mimicking approaching and receding aircraft. The targets successfully intercepted, meeting mission objectives.

INCREDIBLE INDIA







Soaring above the surrounding rugged mountainscape, at 3,600 ft, the Kumbhalgarh Fort can be seen much before one arrives at its foot. With the second-longest wall in the world, about 38 km long, the Kumbhalgarh Fort is recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Everything about the fort has been built to fend off the enemy. From its high position in the Aravalli Hills and its strong ramparts to the four main gates of Aaret, Hanuman, Hulla and Ram Pol, and the Badal Mahal, the fort was almost inaccessible. Moreover, the surrounding 13 mountain peaks and numerous watchtowers made it more of a challenge for the enemy. Historical records suggest that it was only once that the fort was besieged.

Exploring the fort is an unforgettable experience. From its high vantage points, which provide sweeping views of the Thar Desert, to its beautiful interiors and various sections like the Badal Mahal and the Kumbh Mahal, there's much to see. There are as many as 360 Hindu and Jain temples inside the fort and devotees can pay obeisance at them.
